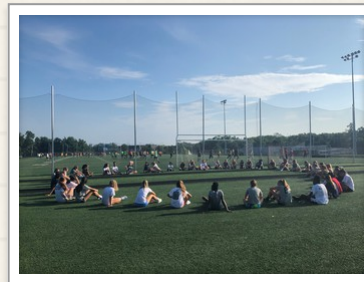
My homecoming is off to a great start! I am excited about the year ahead and truly looking forward to getting to know you all.
