Entries are open for the 29th Annual "Champions of Courage" Black History Month Essay Competition, presented by FOX 45, The CW Baltimore, and MyTV Baltimore. The competition is open to all Maryland students grades 6 through 12.

"Champions of Courage" is a showcase for students to salute their personal heroes or mentors.... positive role models who have demonstrated the teachings of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and have inspired them to dream and achieve.

Students can enter by writing a brief essay saluting their "Champion of Courage". One entry per student.

Essays will be judged on language art skills and execution of the competition theme.

Essays become the property of WBFF-TV FOX 45.

The judges' decision is final.
