Students read and comprehend at grade level.

Students should be able to read 5-10 pages of literature each night. 4-6 major works will be covered

 Students should be able to write a multi-paragraph essay with guidance.

Students should identify and correct errors in grammar, usage, and mechanics.

English 9 Honors

- Students should enjoy reading and writing.
- Students read and comprehend at least one level above grade level.
- Students should be able to read 11-20 pages a night.
- **5**-7 major works will be covered
- Should independently be able to write a multi-paragraph essay which includes textual analysis
- Students should write without errors in subject-verb agreement, pronoun case, and sentence structure (no fragments or run-ons)
- Students should identify and correct their own errors after proofreading or peer editing.
- Students should compose and comprehend on a figurative level.

English 9 GT

- Students should regularly read for pleasure
- Students read and comprehend at least two years above grade level.
- Students should be able to read 20-40 pages a night.
- **6**-8 major works will be covered
- Students should interpret literature beyond a literal level.
- Students should independently be able to write a multi-paragraph essay with an introduction, transitions, supporting details with textual analysis, and a conclusion.
- Students' writing should demonstrate excellent grammar, usage, sentence structure, and variety.
- Students should identify and correct their own errors after proofreading or peer editing.
- Students should be able to read two long works simultaneously for comparison and analysis.

English 9 Seminar
