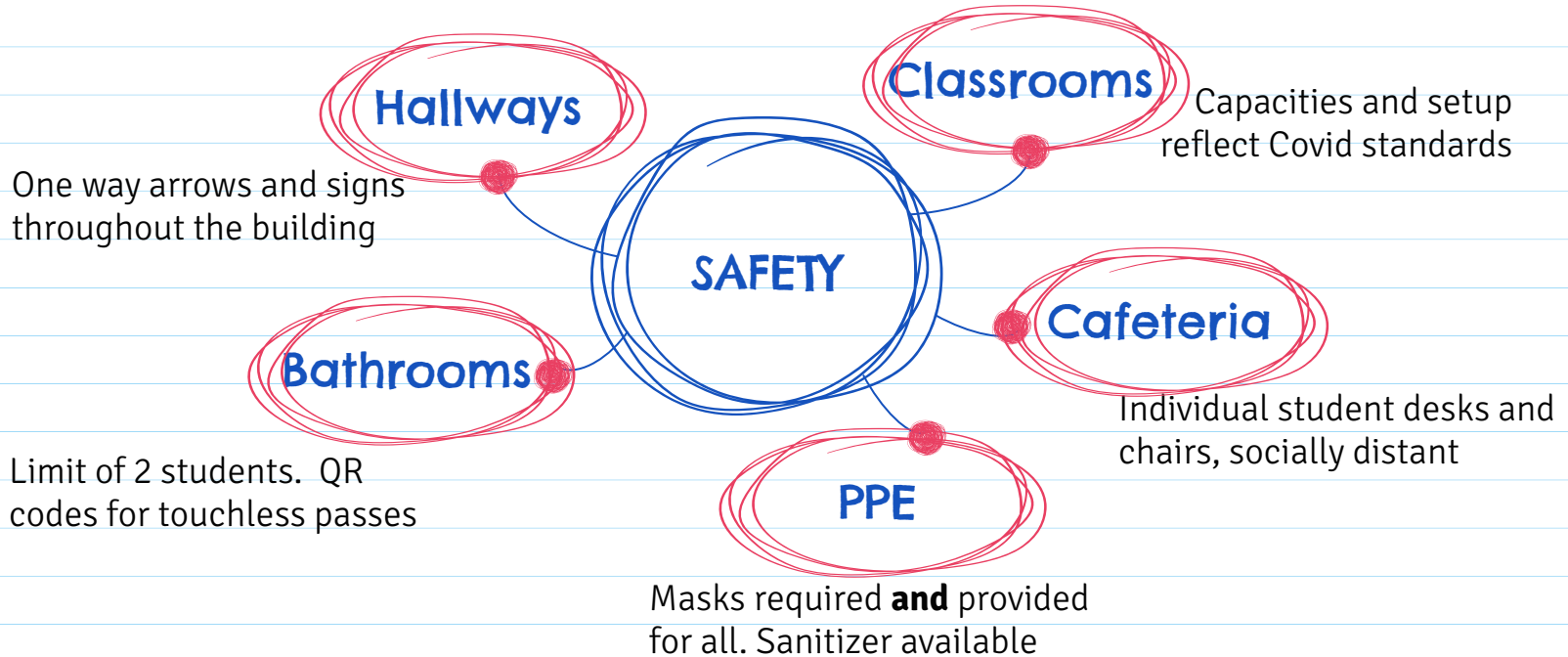

Group E is our smallest group of targeted students...more students in 3 weeks




Composed of 1 - 7 students depending on class

## Concurrent Teaching

## List of Items

Things to bring to school each day:

- HCPSS Chromebook or personal device
- Charger for your device (power cord)
- Headphones / earbuds
- Face Mask
- School supplies (paper, pen/pencil, notebook, textbook)
- Phone (for QR codes)



## List of Items


Things to bring to school each day:

- A water bottle (to avoid use of water fountains)
- A book for pleasure reading, puzzles or another activity to keep busy during breaks between instructional sessions
- A jacket or outdoor wear when weather-appropriate, as school buses will have windows open to promote air circulation

## Arrival

- Bus / Car Drop-Off
