- **5.** A copy of the applicant's SAT scores from the testing center. Email this report to <u>scholarships@centralmd.afceachapters.org</u>. AFCEA is not listed as a site that scores be sent to. Simply copy/scan the report and attach it in an email to the email address provided. The copy must include applicant's name.
- 6. Two letters of recommendation: one letter must be from an academic person (i.e., a school official teacher, principal) and one letter must be from a non-academic person (i.e., a person outside of school clergy, a person you work/intern for, a volunteer leader, a coach). Letters from school counselors are not acceptable. Letters should be specific to this scholarship and not be letters that are for entry to a university or college. Letters may be emailed to <u>scholarships@centralmd.afceachapters.org</u>. Please follow up with the persons who are emailing letters of recommendation to ensure that they have submitted them.
